Dear Parents

This is to inform all the students that dress-code/uniform is compulsory. All the students are required to come in dress-code/uniform EVERYDAY, even during the Practical or special days.

MONDAY, WEDNESDAY, FRIDAY	YELLOW SHIRT, GREEN TROUSERS / GREEN TUNICS, SCHOOL TIE, SCHOOL BELT, YELLOW SOCKS	BLACK
TUESDAY, THURSDAY	BLUE TRACK SUIT, BLUE SOCKS	BLACK

1. Baggy, flared, tight-fitting, low waist or multi-pleated trousers will not be allowed.
2. All students will wear the prescribed school uniform during class hours and at all school functions.
3. Boys are expected to have proper haircuts and not to follow weird hairstyles. At no time must the hair fall over the shirt collar.
4. Girls are either to keep their hair no longer than the collar or if longer, then a double plait up to class V and a single plait from class VI upwards tied with black Rubber Band.
5. No dyeing of hair and wearing make-up and lipstick are permitted.
6. Girls are only permitted to wear small ear studs.
7. Gold ornaments and jewellery is not allowed. School Management is not responsible for any loss
8. No boy is allowed to wear ear-ring, ring, etc.
9. Students from class V onwards are permitted to wear a watch. It should not be a Smart Watch.
10. Nails should be trimmed properly and students are not expected to use nail polish.
11. Students are advised to keep their ID cards in their school bag after they reach home.
12. Care must be taken that the uniform is washed and ironed well and worn with clean socks and polished black shoes.
13. Personal hygiene is of paramount importance and students should take care and be responsible to be well turned out at all times.
14. All the students should have complete awareness of ways to maintain personal hygiene.
15. Students without proper uniform, without wearing ID card and without carrying school Almanac will be charged Fine of Rs. 10/- on first offence. After that, they are not allowed in the school campus and are liable to be sent home.
